## GENERAL PROSPECTUS 'A'

(This prospectus, whether circulated or not, will cover and be applicable to all National Cycle Polo Championships Organised in India.)

1. The Championships will be played under rules and regulations of the CPFI.
2. The matches shall be played under official draws to be taken out by the Technical Committee which shall meet minimum one day before each championship on dates to be declared in the prospectus 'B'.
3. The championships will be played on the dates confirmed and declared by the federation under prospectus form 'B'.
4. Unless otherwise notified, the matches shall be played on league-cum-knock-out basis. Accordingly the matches shall consist of 4. Chukkars of 7½ minutes each. The losing semi-finalists will play a match among themselves to get 3rd and 4th positions.
5. All such affiliated bodies who have prior cleared all their federation dues and have filed all document required by the federation, shall only be eligible to participate in the championships.
6. Entry form duly filled up and complete in all respect must be submitted as per the conditions printed in the form under registered cover minimum 48 hours before the start of championships. After laps of 48 hours and before laps of 24 hours before the start of championship, the same will be accepted only with the double the amount of entry fees. No entry will be accepted after laps of 24 hours before the start of the championship.
7. As all federation record including the merit certificates are prepared according to the entry forms, the same must either be typed or legible written by hand. Illegible particulars in the entry form may be refused. No corrections in the certificates and federation records will be permissible thereafter.
8. Each participating official team shall consist of 4 players with 4 extra players for substitution, one coach and one team manager, thus making a total of 10 persons per team to be provided free accommodation by the host.
9. The D.A. will be payable by the host to the participating players of the official teams along with their coach cum manager, for the actual declared dates of the championships, as per the existing CPFI rules.
