Minute No. 1: Minutes of the last meeting were read out and the same were approved.

Minute No. 2: Secretary read out the activity report of the Federation for the year 2022-23. The members unanimously approved of the same. The presented Annual Report is attached with the minutes.

Minute No. 3: Secretary presented the audited accounts for the year ending 31st March 2023. CEO Sh. Gajanan Burde informed the members present that in view of the due salary of the Assistant Secretary and to refund the advance received towards grant in aid to Nagpur nationals which unfortunately was cancelled due to Covid, it was approved by the House to obtain loan and advances.

He further informed that to ensure that the Federation's recognition continues amounts have been received as loan through President Sh. Pradeep Bapat, Sh. Raghuvendra Soren Dandod and Sh. Gajanan Burde as shown in the Balance Sheet year ending 31/3/2023 and from that part salary of the Assistant Secretary have been paid, TDS on the same has been deducted and advance of grant in aid has been refunded. The members present unanimously approved the Balance Sheet of year ending 31/3/2023.

Minute No. 4: - Secretary informed the members that the decision taken by the Executive Committee are as under

Minute No. 5: Secretary informed that most of the States have cleared their dues and only inactive States have not paid. It was unanimously agreed that one more time defaulted States should be asked to clear their dues failing which their affiliation should be terminated.

Minute No. 6: - CEO informed the members that matter of pending grant in aids for the years 2021-22 and 2022-23 is being pursued with the SAI and all relevant documents have been submitted once again.

Minute No. 7: - President asked all members present to ensure that their respective States are in tune with the Government guidelines and directions, failing which Federation shall have no option but to remove their membership.

He further suggested that the State which are not registered and are inactive should be given stern warning and we all should find alternative and active people to run the sport.



Minute No. 8: - Matter of Kerala court case was discussed at length and the members were informed that Mr. AMK Nizar is continuing to file cases to participate at the National championships through the court. Members were also informed that as per the suggestion of the Federation, members of the Cycle Polo Association of Kerala approached the other party to resolve the matter amicably in the interest of the players and the sport but unfortunately Mr. Nizar refused to accept any suggestion. Pending cases are going on which the Federation is attending.

Minute No. 9: - Secretary asked for the proposals for National Championships for the year 2023-24. As no member opted for the same President suggested that members should discuss the same in their respective State and give written proposal within a month.

Minute No.10:- Any other matter

- A. President suggested that to promote the sport more activities are required and members should conduct zonal and invitational cycle polo tournaments.
- B. Sh. Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod suggested that Federation should renew or obtain fresh Certificate of 12 A and 80 G.
- C. Sh. Gajanan Burde informed the members that as per the SAI rules the time frame to host the national championships is from January to December, however Federation has sent a request letter to grant permission to host the Nationals till 31/3/2024.
- D. Sh. G Kumar of Pondicherry Cycle Polo Association submitted a request letter seeking financial assistance of Rs.20,000,00/- to settle the matter with the Parents of the player who unfortunately died in a drowning accident during South Zone championship. Sh. Gajanan Burde explained the members that the matter is not related to the Federation as the player in question went out of the premises without permission when the matches were going on. Also Police has also accepted it as an accident.
- E. Sh. G Kumar of Pondicherry Cycle-Polo Association submitted a request letter stating that only IAF, Army and TA remains on top and State players do not get the opportunity. It was explained that 2 different kind of rules cannot be made for the National championships. Sh. Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod suggested that the Federation Cup can be played on handicap basis so that the weaker team gets advantage. Members present agreed with the suggestion and it was decided to work out a system to allot the handicap at the time of the next Senior (Men) nationals.



Minute No.1 - Minutes of the ;ast meeting were read out and confirmed.

Minute No.2 - Secretary placed before the members the activity report for the year 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 giving details on the Sub Junior , Junior, Senior (Men) and Women national cycle polo championships. He informed the members that due to Covid 19, no nationals were held during the 2020-21 but the Federation (Men) was held at Pestleweed School, Dehradun ( Utrakhand) in the year 2021-22. Senior, Junior and Sub Junior nationals in the Women section were held at Gharsana (Rajasthan) in March 2022 and Senior, Junior and SUBJunior nationals in the men section were held at Mysore, Karnataka in February 2022. The Secretary's report is attached.

Minute No.3: Audited accounts for the year 2020-2021 and 2021-22 were placed before the members by the Treasurer and the same was approved.

Minutes No.4 : The secretary read out the decisions taken by the Executive Committee in its meeting and the same were approved by the members present.

Minute No.5 - Secretary informed the members that after the last meeting acircular was sent to allthe affiliated states / Units to clear their dues. He further informed the mebers that most of the active States / Units have cleared their dues except few . The President and members were happy to know that the State Associations / Units are taking their responsibilities seriously. The President asked to send a notice to the defaulting states and ask them to clear their dues.

Minute No.6 -Secretary informed the members that earlier the Ministry was sending the grant in aid towards the salary of the Assistant Secretary to the Federation account and then Federation then paid salary to the Assistant Secretary and sent receipts to the Ministry. Since the Sports Authority of India has been given charge, the salary of the Assistant Secretary was not released and reminders were sent regularly. In a period of 3 years f the pending salary the Federation fulfilled all the requirements of the SAI and presented every document that was asked for. SAI later informed the Federation that the rules for grant in aid is changed and it is now reimbursed to the Federation and hence now Federation has to pay the due salary of 3 years to the Assistant Secretary , deduct TDS on the same and send TDS deposit document, bank statement showing payment to the Assistant Secretary and then they shall reimburse the amount which is near about 17 Lakh.

Secretary informed the members that the the Federation is not in a financial situation to pay such a huge amount and hence requested the members to contribute in this regard either as loan or donation. Sh. V R Channawar Joint Secretary suggested that in place of can States / Units should pay 5 years affiliation fee. He said in this way each state will be able to contribute Rs.50,000/- and the total sum will be sustantial. Secretary further suggested that in above regard provision of Advances and Loans from members and othrs should be approved. Members unanimously agreed and approved the same.

**Minute No.7** - Secretary informed the members present that since 2013-14 grant in aid towards the national cycle polo championships are pending. The Federation has been pursuing the matter but the Ministry has clarified now that the matter of grants for the period 2016-17 have been closed but the Ministry and SAI will consider other pending grants.

**Minute No.8-** President informed the members that both the Ministry and SAI have become very strict in regard to adoption of NSDC 2011. He further informed the members that not only National Federations but State Associations also fall in the same category and they also need to follow the guidelines of the NSDC 2011. He then asked the Secretary to outline the requirement to fulfill by the State Associations. Secretary then explained the following:

- **Rules for the State**
  - a) Registration of the State Association
  - b) Memorandum and Byelaws
  - c) 50% affiliation Districts
  - d) Affiliated Districts should be registered
  - e) Audit
  - f) Calendar of Events of State
- **PFMS enrollment of the Federation**



It is now mandatory to enroll in the PFMS portal where all transactions done from the Government have to be uploaded and accounted for. Similarly the Federation had to enroll with Niti Ayog and Darpan where all Nationals and other events are to be uploaded.
- **Compulsory documents after the Nationals**

Secretary informed the members that once Nationals are conducted the host must submit the following documents within 15 days after the championships: Invitation cards/ press cuttings/ photographs/ original bills of expenditures/ Income and expenditure and Audited Accounts.

**Minute No. 9.-** Secretary informed the members that a letter was issued to the Secretary UP Cycle Polo Association in regard to the misconduct by one of their Junior Girls Team members in the Sub Junior Girls Nationals as being the Junior player she played in sub junior category in one chukker. Reply of the letter has been received and the UP Cycle Polo Association has agreed that it was a mistake of their team member and the person responsible has been suspended for a month. They have assured that in future such mistake will not be repeated.

**Minute No.10** - Secretary informed that Sh.M L Nayak had applied for Dronacharya Award without the information to the Federation. He further complained at the PM office without any knowledge of the Federation. Secretary further informed that the reply of Sh.M L Nayak sent in response to the show cause notice was insufficient. Sh. M L Nayak was asked to present his case as to why no action should be taken against him. Sh M L Nayak apologised and gave a written apology stating that in future he shall abide by the directions of the federation and shall not repeat such mistake. He further stated that looking at the long services to the Federation his apology be accepted.

The President informed the House that no correspondence should be done either by the Member of affiliated State Association without the knowledge and consent of the Federation.





**Minute No.11** - Uttar Pradesh Cycle Polo Association opted to host the 41st Junior (Boys) and 25th Junior (Girls) National Cycle Polo Championships to be hosted at Hindalco Renukoot and Sh. Suvendro Mullick of Bengal Association opted for the 19th Sub Junior (G), 37th Sub Junior (B) and 43rd Senior (M) Nationals at Ranaghat Bengal.

Secretary informed the members that submission to apply for the grant in aid towards the Nationals to the Ministry is 3 months prior to the Championships and all Nationals are to be conducted before 31st March hence both UP and Bengal Associations must submit their written proposal with confirmation within 15 days of the meeting. He further suggested if within 15 days written proposals are not received, Federation shall decide the date and venue of the Nationals 2022-23. Members unanimously approved of the same.

**Minute No.12 - Any other matter**

a) The Secretary informed the members that due to Covid 19, Nationals scheduled at Nagpur could not be held but the advance grant was received. SAI therefore sked for a refund of this advance amount as in PFMS portal this was shown s an unspent amount. Secretary further informed that ill this unspent amount of Rs.8,25,000/- is not returned future grant of the Federation will not be cleared.

Secretary further informed that in above regard provision of Advances and Loans from Members and Others should be approved. Members unanimously agreed and approved of the same.



b) Secretary informed the members that an amount of Rs.300,000/ is still outstanding from Lemon Tree Hotel. The President was requested to send a reminder of this outstanding amount and also ask Grp Captain Deepak Ahluwalia to pursue the matter.

c) Secretary informed that Telangana has not paid rs.2000/- towards the players transfer fee of Hazira Begum.

d) Secretary informed the members that the Telangana Senior (M) and Junior (B) teams manager tried to misuse the certificate of Coach and Manager by giving their names as players. This was brought to the notice of the Secretary Telangana Sh G C Rao and letter was issued to him. However no action was taken and hence certificates of the players were issued but certificates of coach and manager were withheld. Members took strong view of this and warned Sh G C Rao that if such incident is repeated strict action will be taken.

e) Secretary informed the members that as per NSDC 2011 required amendments have been adopted by the Federation and will continue to do so as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Sports and NSDC 2011.

f) Sh. Vijay Jaiswal submitted the proposal to the host the Memorial Cycle Polo Tournament every year/ Members were happy to know this. President asked Sh. Vijay Jaiswal to submit a proper plan with date and venue in this regard to further look into this matter.

g) Members requested the President to approach the cycle companies like Hero, Atlas and others for sponsorship. President assured members that he will do the needful.

h) Sh V R Channawar suggested that the age limit of Sub Junior changed to 16 years and Junior to 19 years. This will help increase the participation. President was of the opinion that approval from the Ministry of Sports should be taken before changing the age limit and if its approved changes as suggested can be implemented.


i) The Secretary informed the members that umpires have requested to increase their remuneration and travelling allowances. He proposed as under ;

- If train concession is available , Federation will pay 3rd AC fare. If concession is not available then as per present practice full sleeper fare will be given.
  - Honorarium to be paid Rs.500/- per day for actual championship days.
- Incidental charges will be increased from 250/ to Rs.500/-


Members present unanimously approved of the same and secretary was requested to implement these from 2022-23 National championships.

j) Sh. R S Dumlod proposed that the Federation Cup Championship be held on handicap basis as this will improve the quality and standard of the game. The President welcomes the suggestion and proposed that a 3 member handicap committee will be made to allot handicap during the senior nationals . Members unanimously approved of the same.

- F) Yearly Audit and Balance Sheet
- G) Election report.


Secretary brought to the notice of the Members present that Federation has been sending regular letters and emails in this regard but only few responded and other totally ignored the letters and emails.

President took a serious view on this and asked the members that they must take this matter seriously and submit all required documents to the Federation within 2 weeks from the date of this meeting. He further informed the members that Federation can not suffer due to irresponsible behaviour of the State Association.

Minute No 3 - Secretary suggested that if the Members fail to comply with the requirements of the Ministry of Sports Government of India Federation must take strict action against such State member. President informed the members that within 2 weeks all member States must submit the required documents. If certain document is not available immediately process to procure the same should be done under intimation to the Federation.

He further informed the members that after the stipulated time ,no warning or notice shall be given to the defaulting State and suitable action will be taken .



House observed a 2 minutes silence in memory of the following departed soul.

**Minute No.1** – President read out the minutes of the last meeting and highlighted the following issues

- a) Federation Cup (Men) was held at the Air Force Base Chandigarh by the efforts of Air Marshal P P Bagat and Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia.
- b) A meeting with Kerala State Sports Council was held and issue of A M K Nizar and affiliated state association of Kerala was discussed at length. President informed the members that Kerala State Sports Council has agreed to recognize only that association which has affiliation with the Federation.
- c) Bengal and some other tried to disrupt the Federation but the matter was timely resolved.
- d) States were sent circulars to submit their documents such as registration certificate, annual activity report, list of office bearers but except a few, states have not complied with the same.
- e) Regarding Zonal Championship, President informed all members that zones for cycle polo is already in existence hence those who are interested to have zonal championships can work out the dates and inform Federation, if any assistance is required.
- f) As decided 2019-20 women nationals were conducted at Gondia (Maharashtra) but men nationals could not be held at Rajasthan as was proposed and was shifted to Nagpur in March but due to corona the same could not be held.
- g) President informed members that time and again subject of School Games, University Games and LNCPE Courses are raised. In regard to School Games and University Games Secretary Sh. Gajanan Burde informed the members present that until or unless states are not active in their districts, enroll schools in their activities and conduct state championships, these 2 issues will not be resolved as Federation has no role to play in this. Regarding LNCPE Cycle Polo Course Sh. R K Mohanty Orissa and Sh. Arun Patil Karnataka extended their help. Minutes of the last meeting, thereafter were approved unanimously.


**Minute No.2** – Secretary Sh. Gajanan Burde read out his report and the same was unanimously approved.

**Minute No.3** – President placed before the members the audited accounts for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020. President informed members present that due to regular persuasion of the Secretary dues from the States have been recovered but still some States are in default and House will take suitable action on them.

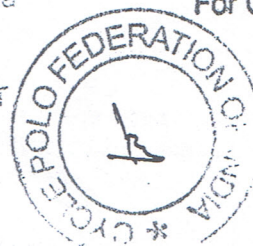
The Audited Accounts for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 was duly approved thereafter.

**Minute No.4** – Secretary informed the members that States must clear their dues in time as once they get accumulated it becomes more difficult for them to pay them. Simultaneously Federation faces a lot of difficulty to run the office in non availability of finances. It is also difficult to explain the Ministry of Sports as to why Federation does not take action on defaulter states.

Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia proposed that a circular to all defaulting states be sent giving them 3 months to clear their dues or else every month a penalty of 10% of the amount will be charged for another 3 months. If dues are not cleared even after 3 months of penalized period, the state / unit concern will be automatically disaffiliated without further notice.

Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia further proposed that any state opting for the Nationals must deposit Rs.20,000/- along with proposal giving details. Once the teams reach the venue, on the opening day the host will get 25% of the sanctioned grant amount received. Host will then submit all required documents to the Federation within 15 days to avail the balance grant in aid.

Both above proposals were unanimously accepted by the House.

**Minute No.5** – President requested Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia to give report on Cycle Polo League as he was instrumental to get the sponsors for the CPL. Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia informed the members present that once Bradford and Franchise India backed out, it had fallen on the Federation to conduct the Cycle Polo League. He thanked AM P P Bapat, Sh. Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod and Sh. Gajanan Burde to support him and he was able to arrange sponsors. He was happy to inform the House that players from France, Malaysia and Germany came and huge publicity was given by the media.

Members thanked Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia for his efforts, AM P P Bapat, President and Secretary for their support to make the 1<sup>st</sup> Cycle Polo League a success.

**Minute No. 6** – President informed the members about India's participation at 12<sup>th</sup> World Cup Cycle Polo Championship held at Argentina in Dec 2019. He informed the members that Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia and Secretary Sh. Gajanan Burde accompanied the team.

Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia informed the House that Indian team played very well and was happy to inform that Ambassador HE Sh. Dinesh Bhatia invited the Indian contingent for tea in his office and witnessed the finals. Gold Medalist Indian team was invited for dinner at his home. Members applauded to this news and congratulated the team India and officials.

**Minute No.7-** President informed that Ministry of Sports has introduced new logo of SAI and the same is to be included in certificates, banners etc of the Federation at the time of the Championships.

**Minute No. 8** – President informed the members that after many years of correspondence and persuasion Cycle Polo has been included in the approved list of sports for central government jobs.

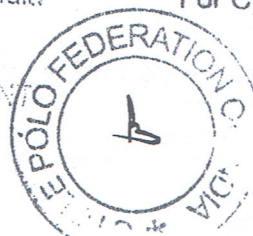
**Minute No. 9** – President informed the members that an amount of Rs.15 Lac is due from the Ministry of Sports Government of India towards the salary of Assistant Secretary. This is mainly due to non compliance of documents by the State Association after conducting the nationals. He therefore emphasized that Federation will henceforth be strict with such states.

**Minute No.10** – Secretary informed the House that due to corona, Sub Junior (B), Junior(B) and Senior (M) Nationals of 2019-2020 could not be held. Ministry had once given us the approval to host the nationals but due to travel restrictions in some states and restrictions on gathering in Rajasthan, the same could not be held. He further informed that now SAI had asked for justification as advance amount was released for the said championships. The same has been given and now the championships in questions will be held in the year 2020-2021. The states who wish to host the national championship must submit their bid along with the deposit amount of Rs.20,000/- for the year 2020-2021.

In regard to the calendar of 2020-2021 the Secretary informed the House that Railways has cancelled the facility of sports concession due to Covid 19 , as trains are running under special guidelines laid down by the Government of India. He explained that under such circumstances it will not be possible for teams to attend the nationals.

It was therefore decided that a letter be sent to the Ministry of Sports Government of India to resume the facility of concession so that National Federations could continue with their activities.

**Minute No.11** - The Secretary informed that normally Federation Cup (Women) is held with the women nationals but if anyone opts for it separately , the same will be allotted.

The postponed Federation Cup (Men) will now be held at Dehradun in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of February 2021 by Ultratraind Cycle Polo Association.

**Minute No.12** - President informed the members present that sport activist Rahul Mehra has filed case against the Ministry of Sports, Government of India for compliance of National Sports Code 2011. As a result of this Ministry has become very strict with the Federations in granting recognition and grants . He therefore emphasized that member states and units ensure to fulfill all documents required and asked by the Federation.

As the last point of the agenda was Elections of the new Executive , members of the electoral college were requested to attend the proceedings.



The outgoing President and Secretary thanked all the state associations and units for their support during their term and congratulated the newly elected President, Secretary and Members of the Executive.


