Minute No.1 : Minutes of the last meeting were read out and the same were approved.

Minute No. 2: Secretary read out the activity report of the Federation for the year 2022-23. The members unanimously approved of the same. The presented Annual Report is affixed with the minutes.

Minute No. 3 : Secretary presented the audited accounts for the year ending 31st March. CEO Sh. Gajanan Burde informed the members present that in view of the due salary of the Assistant Secretary and to refund the advance received towards grant in aid for Nagpur nationals which unfortunately was cancelled due to Covid, it was approved by the House to obtain loan and advances. He further informed that to ensure that the Federation's recognition continues amounts have been received as loan through President Sh. Pradeep Bapat, Sh. Raghuvendra Singh D. and Sh. Gajanan Burde as shown in the Balance Sheet year ending 31/3/2023 and from the part salary of the Assistant Secretary have been paid, TDS on the same has been deducted and advance of grant in aid has been refunded. The members present unanimously approved the Balance Sheet of year ending 31/3/2023.

Minute No.4 : -- Secretary informed that most of the States have cleared their dues and only inactive States have not paid. It was unanimously agreed that one more time defaulted States should be asked to clear their dues failing which their affiliation should be terminated.

Minute No. 5 :- CEO informed the members that matter of pending grant in aids for the years 2018-19, 2021-22 and 2022-23 is being pursued with the SAI and all relevant documents have been submitted once again.

Minute No 6 : - President asked all members present to ensure that their respective States are in tune with the Government guidelines and directions, failing which Federation shall have no option but to remove their membership. He further suggested that the State which are not registered and are inactive should be given stern warning and we all should find alternative and active people to run the sport.


Minute No. 7: - Matter of Kerala court case was discussed at length and the members were informed that Mr. AMK Nizar is continuing to file cases to participate at the National championships through the court. Members were also informed that as per the suggestion of the Federation, members of the Cycle Polo Association of Kerala approached the other party to resolve the matter amicably in the interest of the players and the sport but unfortunately Mr. Nizar refused to accept any suggestion. Pending cases are going on which the Federation is attending.

Minute No. 8 :- Secretary asked for the proposals for National Championships for the year 2023-24. As no member opted for the same President suggested that members should discuss the same in their respective State and give written proposal within a month.

Minute No 9 - Any other matter

1. President suggested that to promote the sport more activities are required and members should conduct zonal and invitational cycle polo tournaments.
2. Sh. Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod suggested that Federation should renew or obtain fresh Certificate of 12 A and 80 G.

## MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE MEETING

Before the start of the meeting Members paid condolences to the following:

- Sh. Ranvijay Singh Rohet - President Assam Cycle Polo Association
- Sh. T Kumar -- International Player
- Sh. R. Sridhar son of Sh. R. Sathyanarayana Ex Joint Secretary of CPFI
- Sh. G. Sudershan, brother of Sh. G Chander Rao Executive Member CPFI

**Minute No.1** – Minutes of the last meeting were read out and confirmed.

**Minute No.2** – Secretary placed before the members the activity report for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22 giving details on the Sub Junior, Junior, Senior Men and Women National Championships. He informed the members present that due to Covid 19, no nationals were held in the year 2020-2021 but the Federation (Men) was held at Pestleweed School Dehradun (Uttarakhand). In the year 2021-22, Senior Junior and Sub Junior National championships in the Women section were held at Gharsana (Rajasthan) in March 2022. Senior, Junior and Sub Junior Nationals in the men section were held at Mysore (Karnataka) in February 2022. The Secretary's report is attached.

**Minute No.3** – Audited Accounts for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22 were placed before the members by the Treasurer and the same was duly approved.

**Minute No.4** – Secretary informed the members that after the last meeting, a circular was sent to all the affiliated States / Units to clear their dues. He further informed the members that most of the active states have cleared their dues except few. The President and members were happy to know that the State Associations /Units are taking their responsibility seriously. The President asked the Secretary to send a notice to the defaulting states and ask them to clear their dues.

**Minute No.5** – Secretary informed the members that earlier the Ministry was sending the grant in aid towards the salary of the Assistant Secretary to the Federation's bank account and the Federation then paid the salary and was sending the receipts to the Ministry. Since the Sports Authority of India has been given the charge, the salary of the Assistant Secretary was not released and reminders were sent regularly. In a period of 3 years of the pending salary Federation fulfilled all requirements of the SAI and presented every document that was asked for. SAI later informed the Federation that the rule for grant in aid is changed and it is now reimbursed to the Federation and hence now Federation has to pay the due salary of 3 years to the Assistant Secretary, deduct TDS on the same and send TDS deposit document, bank statement showing payment to the Assistant Secretary and then they shall reimburse the amount which is near about 17 Lakh.

Secretary informed the members present that the Federation is not in a financial situation to pay such a huge amount and hence requested the members present to contribute in this regard either as cash or donation. Sh V R Channawar Joint Secretary suggested that in place of loan States / Units should pay 3 years affiliation fee. He said in this way each State will be able to contribute Rs.50,000/- and the total sum will be substantial.

Secretary further suggested that in above regard provision of Advances and Loans from members and others should be approved. Members unanimously agreed and approved the same.

**Minute No. 6** – Secretary informed the members present that since 2013-14 grant in aid towards national cycle polo championships are pending. The Federation has been pursuing the matter with the Ministry and SAI will consider other pending grants.

**Minute No. 7** - President informed the members present that both the Ministry and SAI have been very strict in regard to adoption of NSDC 2011. He further informed the members that...



National Federation but State Associations also fall in the same category and they also need to follow the guidelines of the NSDC 2011. He then asked the Secretary to outline the requirement to fulfill by the State Associations:

Secretary then explained the following:

- **Rules for the State**

- Registration of the State Association.
- Memorandum and Byelaws
- 50% affiliation of Districts.
- Affiliated Districts should be registered.
- Audit
- Calendar of Events of State.

- **PFMS enrollment of the Federation**

It is now mandatory to enroll in the PFMS portal where all transactions done from the Government aid have to be uploaded and accounted for.

Similarly, the Federation had to enroll with Niti Ayog, and Darpan. All national and other events are to be uploaded.

- **Compulsory documents after the nationals.**

Secretary informed the members that once the nationals are conducted, the host must submit the following documents within 15 days after the championship.

Invitation card / press cuttings / photographs / original bills of expenditure / Income & Expenditure & audited account.

Minute No. 8 - Secretary informed the members that a letter was issued to the Secretary UP Cycle Polo Association in regard to misconduct by one of their Junior Girls team members in the Sub Junior Girls National Cycle Polo Championship as being the Junior age group she played in Sub Junior Girls category in one chucker.. Reply of the letter has been received and UP Cycle Polo Association has agreed that it was the mistake of their team member and the person responsible has been suspended for a month. They have assured that in future such mistakes will not be repeated.

The President informed all State members that others should take this matter seriously and ensure that their team members and coach and managers are vigilant so such things does not happen, failing which the Federation will take strong action against such State Association.

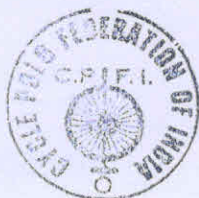
**Minute No. 9 -**

Secretary informed the members that Sh. M L Nayak had applied for Dornacharya Award without the information to the Federation. He further complained at the PM office without any knowledge of the Federation. Secretary further informed that the reply of Sh M L Nayak sent in response to the Show Cause notice was insufficient. Sh M L Nayak was asked to present his case as to why action should not be taken against him.

Sh M L Nayak apologised and gave a written apology stating that in future he shall abide by the directions of the Federation and shall not repeat such mistake. He further stated that looking at his long services to the Federation his apology be accepted.

The President informed the House that no correspondence should be done by either the Member of the Federation or affiliated State Association without the knowledge and consent by the Federation.

Minute No. 10 - Uttar Pradesh Cycle Polo Association opted to host the 41st Junior ( Boys ) and 25th Junior ( Girls ) National Cycle Polo Championships to be hosted at Hindalco , Renukoot and Sh.

Suvendro Mullick of Bengal Association opted for the 19th Sub Junior (G), 23rd Senior (G) Junior (B) and 43rd Senior (Men) National Cycle Polo Championships to be hosted at Rana

Secretary informed the members that submission to apply for Grant in aid towards nationals submitted 3 months prior to the championships and all Nationals must be conducted by 31st UP and Bengal Association must submit their written proposal and confirmation within meeting. He further suggested that if within 15 days the proposals are not received Federation decide the date and venue of the Nationals of 2022-23.

Members unanimously approved of the same.

**Minute No. 11 – Any other matter:**

a) The Secretary informed the members that due to Covid 19, nationals scheduled at not be held but the advance grant was received. SAI thereafter asked for a refund amount as in PFMS portal this was shown as an unspent amount. Secretary further informed this unspent amount of Rs.8,25,000/- is not returned future grant of the Federation cleared.

Secretary further suggested that in above regard provision of Advances and Loans from and others should be approved. Members unanimously agreed and approved the same

b) Secretary informed the members that an amount of Rs.300,000/- is still outstanding at Tree Hotel. The President was requested to send a reminder of this outstanding amount ask Grp Capt Deepak Ahluwalia to pursue the matter.

c) Secretary informed the members that Telangana State has not paid an amount of towards the player's transfer fee of Hazira Begum.

d) Secretary informed the members that the Telangana Senior (Men) and Junior manager tried to misuse the certificate of the Coach and Manager by giving their names him. However no action was taken and hence certificates of the players were issued of coach and manager were withheld. Members took a strong view of this and warned Sh. G Chander Rao that if such incident strict action will be taken.

d) Secretary informed the members that as per NSDC 2011 required amendments have been by the Federation and will continue to do so as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Sports and 2011.

e) Sh. Vijay Jaiswal submitted the proposal to host the Memorial Cycle Polo Tournament. Members were happy to know this. President asked Sh Vijay Jaiswal to submit a proper dates and venue in this regard to further look into this matter.

f) Members requested the President to approach cycle companies like Hero, Atlas and sponsorship. President assured members that he will do the needful.

g) Sh. V R Channawar suggested that the age limit of Sub Junior should be changed to Junior to 19 years. This will help increase participation. The President was of the opinion from the Ministry of Sports should be taken before changing the age and if it is approved age limit can be implemented.

h) The Secretary informed the members that umpires have requested to increase their allowance and remuneration. He proposed as under:

1. If train concession is available Federation will pay 3rd AC fare If concession is not available per present practice full fare of sleeper will be paid.



2 Honorarium be paid at Rs.500/- per day of the actual championship days.

3 incidental charges will be increased from Rs.250/- to Rs.500/-.

Members present unanimously approved of the above proposals and the Secretary was requested to implement these from 2022--2023 National Championships.

Sh. R S Dandlod proposed that Federation Cup Championships be held on handicap basis as this will improve the quality and standard of the game . The President welcomed the suggestion and proposed that a 3 member handicap Committee will be made to allot handicap during the Senior National Championship. Members unanimously approved of the same.

As there was no other matter to be discussed the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

- c) That each member state and unit will affiliate 50% of its districts to get affiliation from the Federation.

Minute No. 3 : Secretary requested all members present to ensure that their respective states are in compliance with the Government guidelines and directions, failing which Federation shall have no option but to terminate their membership.

**Minute No.1** – Minutes of the last meeting were read out by the Secretary and the same were confirmed by the members.

**Minute No.2** – President Air Marshal Pradeep P Bapat (Retd) welcomed the members of the new executive. He further emphasized that it is the responsibility of the members as they also represent their respective state associations to ensure that cycle polo reaches to all districts and have a broad base in schools and colleges.

President also emphasized that no Federation can run without organized and efficient State Members and hence it is the responsibility of the states to pay their dues on time and update their paper work as per the guidelines of the Federation.

**Minute No.3** – Sr Vice President Group Capt Deepak Ahluwalia proposed the following :

- a) Every affiliated State / Unit must participate at the National Championships. It was decided that out of 8 nationals in a year, every affiliated state / unit must participate in 2 ( one men and one women section) . It was further decided that if a member state does not participate in any nationals for 2 years, affiliation of such state be withdrawn.
- b) It was agreed upon that India should host the 13<sup>th</sup> World Cup Cycle Polo Championship in 2022 in a majority to get the maximum publicity.
- c) It was agreed upon that by end February 2021 or at the time of the 15<sup>th</sup> Federation Cup (Men) Sh. Deepak Ahluwalia will present a road map of the Federation.

**Minute No.4** – President Air Marshal Pradeep P Bapat was of the opinion that to run a Federation a team of experienced person is needed. He suggested that Sh. Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod be taken as Life Patron of the Federation and should be a permanent invitee to the Executive and General Body meetings of the Federation. Members unanimously approved of the same and Sh. Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod was nominated as Life Patron of the Federation.

**Minute 5** - President informed the members that in the previous Annual General Meeting post of Honorary CEO was approved . He proposed the name of Sh. Gajanan Burde for the post of Honorary CEO keeping in view of his long association with the Federation, work experience and liaison with the Ministry. Members unanimously approved of the same and Sh.
